WHAT ARE WE DOING?

The Lord is calling us as a church to set aside the month of February to pray and fast and seek the Lord for the manifestation of His power and glory that results in great joy, peace, and deliverance in our lives and city. Join us in 24 hour prayer by signing up for an hour or more once per week for the entire month.

WHY?

We believe the Lord will move and manifest His power and glory in our lives, our families, our church, our city, our province, our country, and in the whole earth. It is our responsibility to ‘ask, seek, and knock’ so the Lord can fulfill His Word in regards to this outpouring.



HOW?

The fast you choose should spur you on to seek God in prayer and act on what the Holy Spirit leads you to do. Here are some types of fasts you can consider:

COMPLETE FAST

Drink only clear liquids (typically water/ light juices)

SELECTIVE FAST

Remove certain elements from your diet. (eg: remove meat, sweets, or breads)

PARTIAL FAST

Abstaining from eating one meal (eg: lunch), or avoid food for certain times of day (eg: 6:00 am to 3:00 pm)

SOUL FAST

Good option for re-focusing on God as your source, or if you have health issues preventing a food fast. Some ideas would be taking a break from something and fill the time you would normally spend on that activity with prayer (eg: social media, recreational shopping, movies, or something that takes your attention away from God)

5 mins: PRAY FOR GROWTH. Ask God to open the doors here in Grande Prairie for the lost and the broken and that the people in our church would feel a burden for the community.

5 mins: PRAY FOR OUR COMMUNITY (the hospital, the teachers, the fire department, the police, etc).

5 mins: LISTEN. Take time and reflect on all the things that you have just prayed for.

5 mins: PRAY for any things that came into your mind while listening to God.

5 mins: PRAISE GOD. Think of all the attributes of God and give him praise (love, kindness, joy, peace, patience, holiness)

5 mins: ASK FOR GOD'S WILL TO BE DONE. When we pray, it is easy to get into the pattern of asking for things to be done as we see fit. God has the best plan, so go back through the guide and ask God for his will to be done above all else in our friends and families lives, in the leaders and staff in the church, in our growth, and in our community

PRAYER GUIDE

5 mins: LISTEN. Take the first couple mins to quiet your heart. Don't come rushed into your time. Simply sit and listen.

5 mins: CONFESS. Take time and confess your sins before the Father. It is important to start prayer off with a clear heart (if you're with another person, don't worry about praying this part out loud)

5 mins: THANK GOD for the great things that He has done (today, this week, this month, this year, in your life, in your family life, in your friends life, in your small group, in our church).

5 mins: PRAY FOR FRIENDS that don't know Jesus (think of friends/ family that do not have a connection to a church).

5 mins: PRAY FOR LEADERS in the church (people that run ministries and studies, the elders and board). Ask for God's blessing, provision and knowledge to be with them.

5 mins: PRAY FOR STAFF in the church (pray for guidance, pray for their family members, and pray for their specific ministry).

THIS IS WHAT THE LORD SAYS...

"The kind of fasting I want is this: Remove the chains of oppression and the yoke of injustice, and let the oppressed go free. Share your food with the hungry and open your homes to the homeless poor. Give clothes to those who have nothing to wear, and do not refuse to help your own relatives. Then my favor will shine on you like the morning sun, and your wounds will be quickly healed. I will always be with you to save you; my presence will protect you on every side. When you pray, I will answer you. When you call to me, I will respond. If you put an end to oppression, to every gesture of contempt, and to every evil word; if you give food to the hungry and satisfy those who are in need, then the darkness around you will turn to the brightness of noon. And I will always guide you and satisfy you with good things. I will keep you strong and well. You will be like a garden that has plenty of water, like a spring of water that never goes dry. Your people will rebuild what has long been in ruins, building again on the old foundations. You will be known as the people who rebuilt the walls, who restored the ruined houses."
